- Engine #3 is working out great
- We have applied for 5 grants
- Working on a recruiting brochure for our Fire department.
- 21 Fire fighters employed to date, \$16.00 an hour. Would like to have day staffing pay go to \$18.00 an hour. We may need a new millage for staffing.
- Road construction is hindering our run time, with the highway having only one lane open and Michigan Avenue Bridge is closed.
- We have asked, Chris Crisenbery with Design Solutions to write up specs for our parking lot. Then we will get back to the three companies who gave us quotes.
- It is not in the budget to do the fire barn alarm system at this time.

Public Comment: Question about the “Adoption of Fire Code.” Chief Engelter said, “I have one for each township, I will try to have it ready to discuss at the December meeting. It needs to go to our legal counsel before it goes into an Ordinance.”

Chamberlain asked about having the brochures so we could each put in on our websites. Chief Engelter will get us all a copy.
