

### **Marijuana Plants/Growing Restrictions within the Village of Parma:**

Per the guidelines established by the State of Michigan, marijuana plants must be kept in an enclosed, secured area that is not accessible by the public. In addition, plants cannot be visible to the public "without the use of binoculars, aircraft, or other optical aids." For this reason, cultivation of marijuana plants should take place indoors, in a shed or similar structure, or a location not visible from the street or any other public area. The designated growing area must be closed and locked so that only the grower has access to the plants.

Violation of this regulation is punishable as a civil infraction with a fine not to exceed \$100 and forfeiture of all plants in violation of the ordinance as determined by the enforcement officer.
